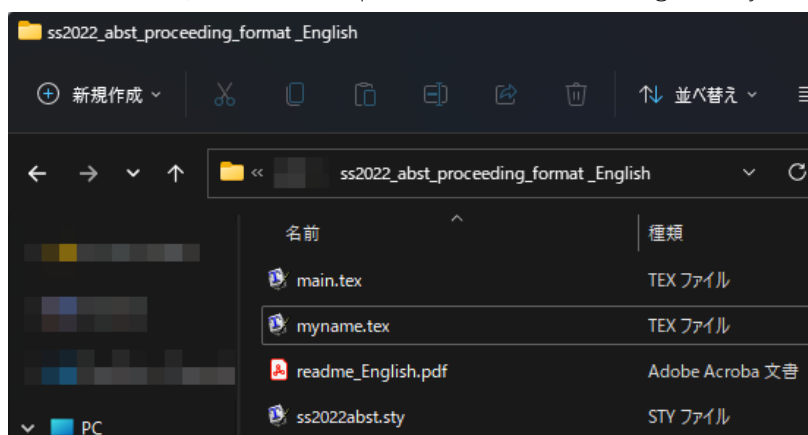


How to make the abstract?

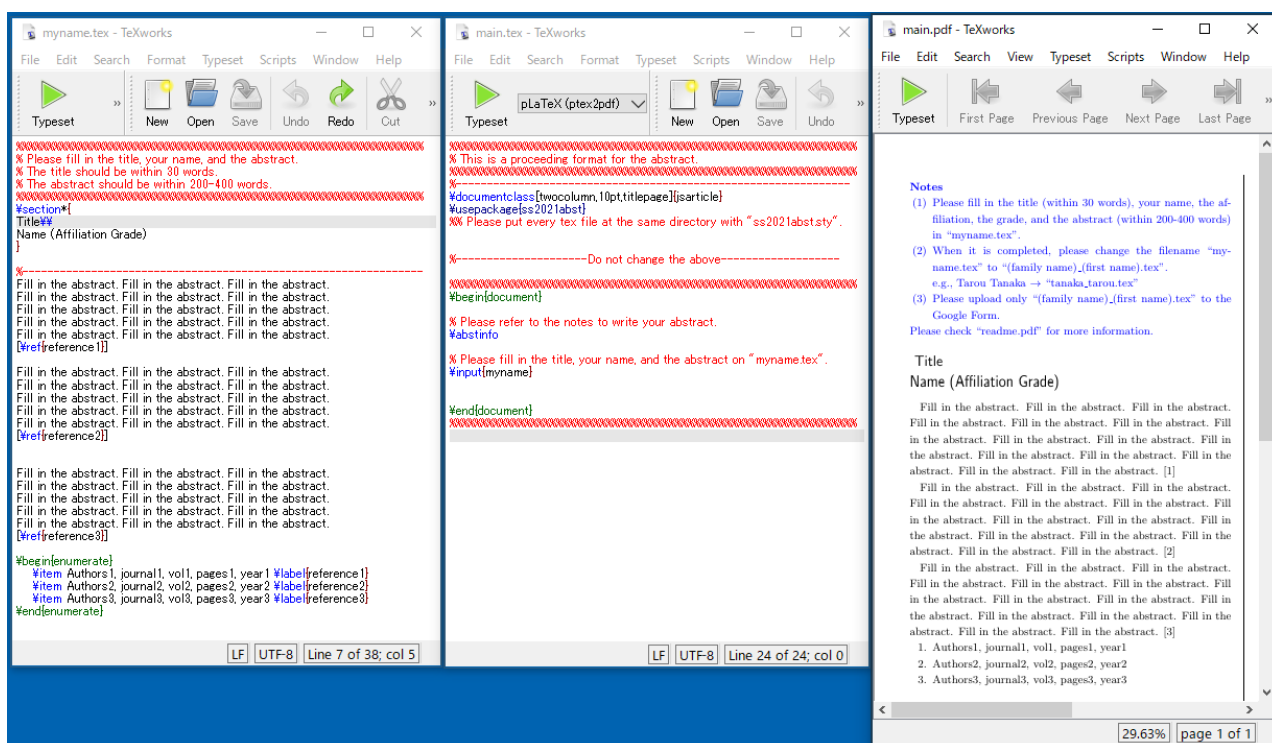
① The source file “ss2022_abst_proceeding_format_English” contains the follows:

- “readme_English.pdf”: This PDF file. It explains how to make the abstract.
- “main.tex”: This is the main TeX document. Please compile this file.
- “myname.tex”: This is the external TeX document which will be imported to “main.tex”. Please put this file at the same directory as “main.tex”. You will fill in the title and the abstract to this file.
- “ss2022abst.sty”: This is the preamble. Please put this file at the same directory as “main.tex”. Please do not edit this file, since we will publish the abstract along this style file.



② Open “main.tex” and “myname.tex”.

When you compile “main.tex”, “main.pdf” will be displayed as follows:



③ Edit “myname.tex” to make the abstract.

Please fill in the title, your name, the affiliation, the grade, and the abstract here.

The title must be within 30 words, and the abstract must be within 200-400 words including reference.

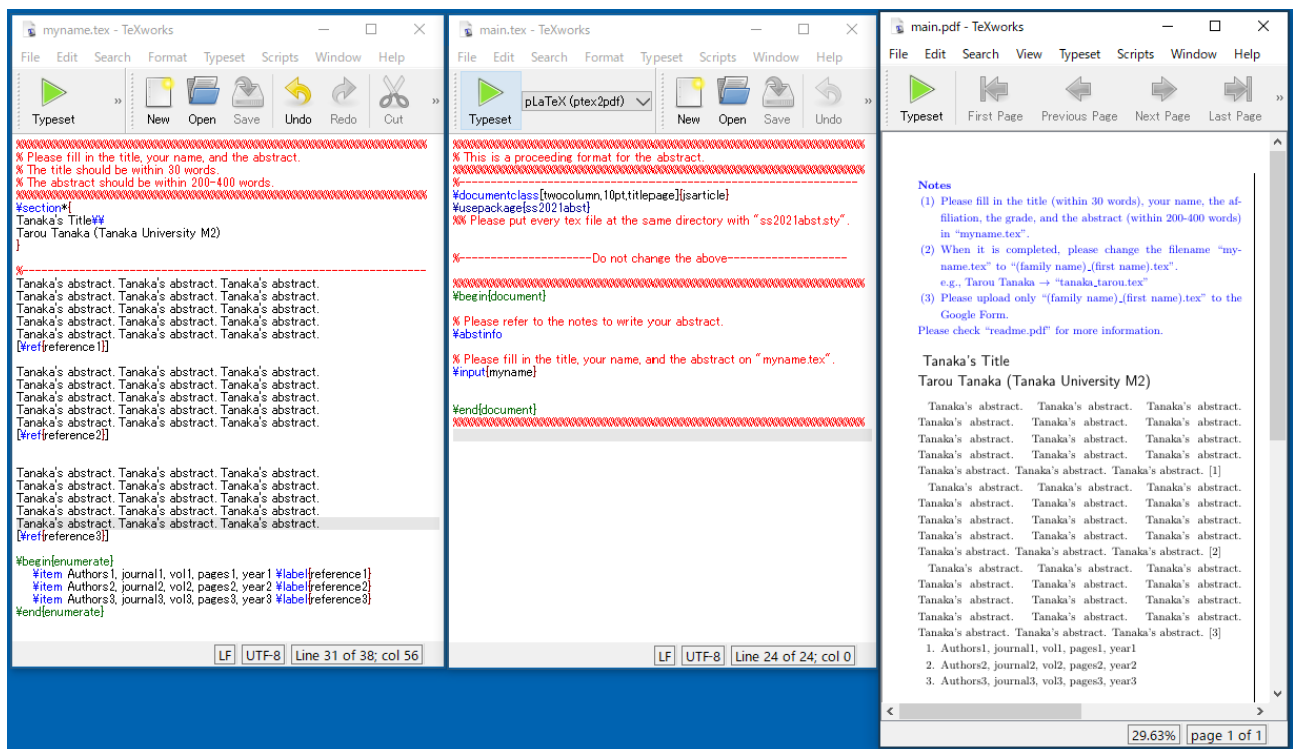
When you cite a paper, please provide a reference of the source of the citation at the end of the sentence, and please cite like `[¥ref{hoge}]` in the sentence.

There is no limit to the number of citations.

However, please note the following two points:

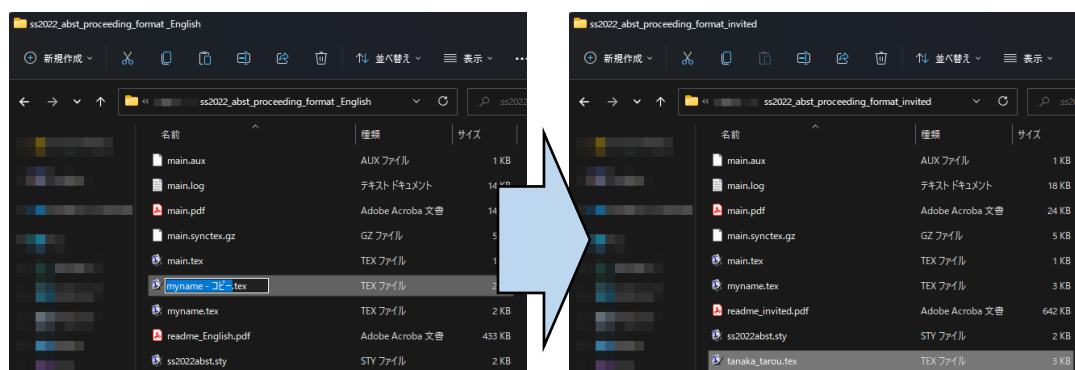
- Please do not use a reference style which needs the external files (e.g. bibtex style).
- Please do not use any packages except listed in the preamble that we have prepared.

After completed, please check if “main.pdf” is compiled successfully.



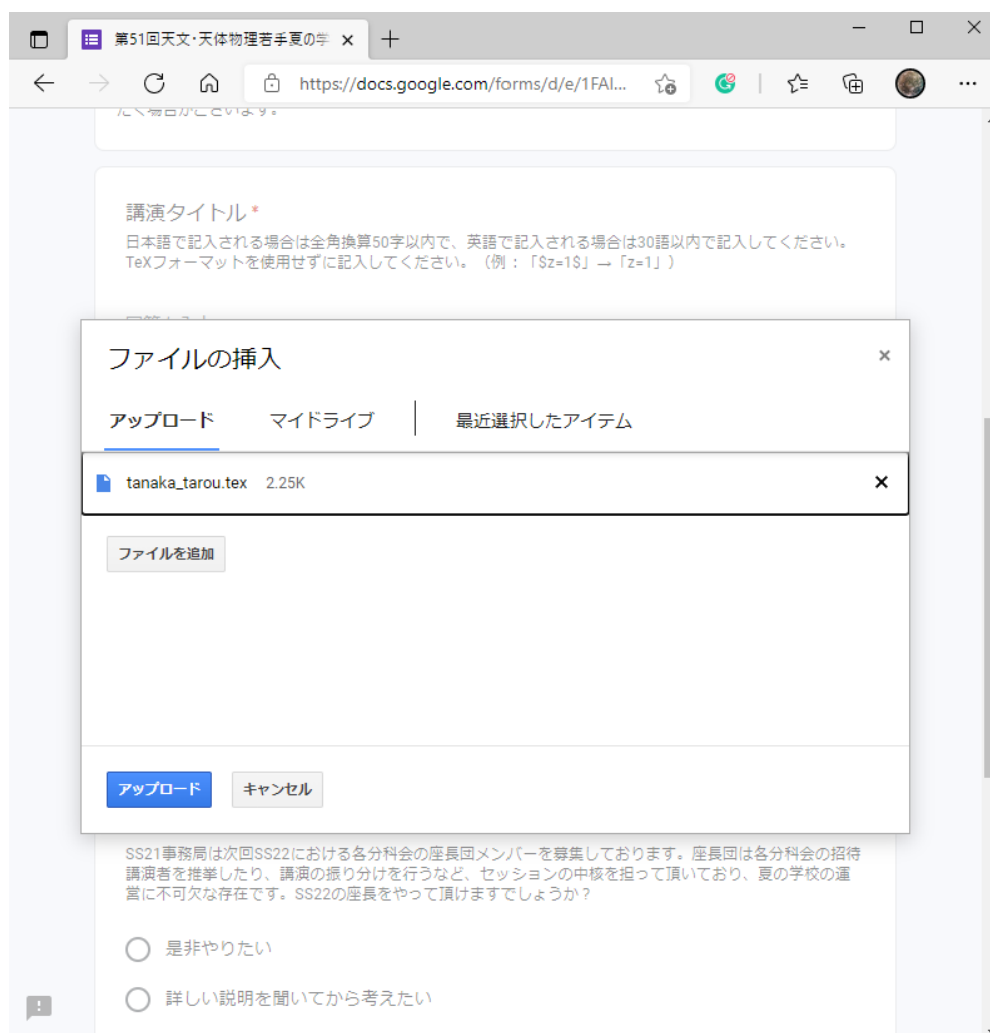
- ④ Copy “myname.tex”, and change its filename to “(family name)_(first name).tex”.

e.g.) Tarou Tanaka → change the filename as “tanaka_tarou.tex”



- ⑤ Upload only “(family name)_(first name).tex” to the Google form.

Please do NOT upload the other files such as “main.pdf”.
